- Have a minimum of ten years of experience including at least 5 years’ experience working in management and administration of projects or programs funded by International Financing Institutions.
- Experience / Knowledge of digital transformation, its stakeholders, initiatives, and agenda within the ECOWAS regional context
- Experience with World Bank project will be an advantage.
- Program or project management certification will be an advantage.
