The Project Preparation and Development Unit (PPDU) is a specialized agency of the ECOWAS Commission and is based in the Togolese Republic. With a view to strengthen the its capacity, the ECOWAS PPDU intends to engage the services of a Sustainable Development Expert on a short-term basis to provide Technical Assistance support to the PPDU in carrying out its mandate of fast tracking the delivery of optimally structured, bankable regional infrastructure projects. This Technical Assistance will be implemented under the framework of the Memorandum of Understanding signed in February 2015 between the ECOWAS Commission and the Spanish Cooperation for International Development (AECID).

The overall objective of the technical assistance is to support the PPDU in incorporating sustainable development in its project preparatory activities.

The consulting services ("the Services") shall include but not necessarily limited to the duties and responsibilities outlined below:

Scope of Service

- Develop a comprehensive set of guidelines to ensure mainstreaming of sustainable development elements including climate change, inclusive growth, gender mainstreaming and knowledge management in PPDU project preparatory activities;
- Advise on strategies to facilitate access by PPDU to Green Financing;
- Develop a mechanism to allow rapid preliminary environment and social impact assessment of regional projects;
- Recommend clear set of action points to enhance sustainable development in all PPDU activities;
- Actively participate and contribute to all meetings / workshops organized by PPDU.

• The duration of the contract shall be for a period of 6 calendar months renewable up a maximum of 12 months subject to satisfactory performance
